# END TIME LIVING

...in the last days, difficult times will come  
2 Timothy 3:1

We are now in our third 90 day phase of unified worship, prayer and praise which starts Monday, September 2, 2024 through Saturday, November 30, 2024. Choose 1 or more hours you will cover. As before, you may choose 5:00am – 6:00am, 12noon – 1:00pm or 6:00pm – 7:00pm, Monday through Saturday. This time we are asking that you start your prayer time in worship, which is the highest form of prayer, for at least 5 minutes or until the Holy Spirit leads you into the prayer phase. We have listed the areas we will cover, but you will supply the verbiage. So be led by the Holy Spirit on what you should say on the selected subjects. Then as you conclude your prayer effort, give God praise for hearing your petitions, praise Him for answering your petitions and praise Him for blessing your lives!

1. Pray for **strength** and **courage** to face the coming persecution. The one thing that Jesus said to pray for concerning the end times was **STRENGTH**, and so it is number one on our list. **Psalm 46:1**, “**God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.**”

2. **Pray that you maintain your testimony** and have the courage to shine the light of Christ in a dark world. Pray for courage to stand firm in your faith. Be steadfast and immovable. **And pray that you might be fearless** when confronting evil and giving your testimony, 2 Timothy 1:7-8, “for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control. Therefore, do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, nor of me his prisoner, but share in suffering for the gospel by the power of God.”

3. **Pray for boldness** to speak the gospel even amidst opposition, speaking, not as pleasing men but God who examines our heart. **Pray not to be afraid** to speak truth in love to those around you. 1 Thessalonians 2:2-4, “But even after we had suffered

before and were spitefully treated at Philippi, as you know we were bold in our God to speak to you the gospel of God in much conflict. For our exhortation did not come from error or uncleanness, nor was it in deceit. But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts”.

4. **Pray for physical protection for yourself, family and all believers. Pray that the LORD would encamp around you;** that He send angels to hide and shield you from harm and danger. Pray that the LORD will hide you in the shadow of His wings.

5. Pray for **wisdom** to overcome deceptions and temptations. Pray for wisdom to navigate the coming obstacles of remaining obedient to the word of God. Pray to maintain self-control and not fall into sin. **James 1:5**, “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.”

6. **Pray that your love does not grow cold.** 1 Thessalonians 3:12, “and may the Lord cause you to increase and abound in love for one another, and for all people.

7. Pray that the Lord will prepare you **mentally** and **spiritually** for what the Bible calls the most perilous time in history. **Matthew 24:21**, “For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.”

8. **Pray for your faith not to waver or falter.** Pray that you and all believers will remain spotless and pure for the return of Jesus (whatever the cost). **1 Peter 1:15**, “but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct”.

9. **Pray that you do not become weary of doing good.** Pray for opportunities to do good for others. Pray for patience. Pray to be a good “waiter.” **Galatians 6:9 NKJV**, “And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap, if we do not lose heart.”

10. Pray for the **fruits** of the **Spirit** to be evidenced in your life, especially for love and self-control. **Galatians 5:22-23 NKJV**, “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against there is no law.”

11. Pray that the **plans of the enemy are confused** and that their evil plans and schemes are thwarted. Pray that the LORD will once again confuse the language of those building the tower of Babel in these last days. **Psalms 55:9 AMP**, “Confuse [my enemies], O Lord, divide their tongues [destroying their schemes], For I have seen violence and strife in the city.”

12. Pray for your **enemies** to be forgiven. Pray to have God's perspective and to see people as he sees them, even those who persecute you. **Matthew 5:44 NKJV**, "But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you."

13. Pray for the **lost** and **deceived** to know the truth and be saved. **II Timothy 2:26**, "and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will."

14. **Praise and thank the LORD** for equipping you with everything you need for the battles ahead. **Ephesians 6:11 NASB**, "Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil."

15. Pray that the **church is awakened and galvanized into action**. That the end-time church is stirred up and energized like the first-century church to speak Christ to those around them with great zeal. **I Corinthians 1:17**, "For Christ did not send me [as an apostle] to baptize, but [commissioned and empowered me] to preach the good news [of salvation] – not with clever and eloquent speech [as an orator], so that the cross of Christ would not be made ineffective [deprived of its saving power]."

16. Pray for the brethren to be **encouraged** and **sustained** during what Jesus called the most distressful and oppressive time in history. **Ephesians 6:18 NKJV**, "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints."

17. Pray for the LORD to send out **laborers** into His harvest. **Luke 10:2**, “Here am I Lord, send me.”

18. Pray that the LORD will **establish** and **manage** your steps each day that you might walk in perfect agreement with His word. **Psalms 37:23**, “The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.”

19. Pray to be ready for the LORD’s return. **Matthew 24:44**, “Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.”
20. Pray for **patient endurance** for yourself and all believers. Pray to be an overcomer by standing firm, trusting, and obeying the word of God. Persevere in faith. Pray for perseverance, persistence, patience, tenacity, steadfastness, determination, resolve, boldness to “withstand in the day of evil” (**Ephesians 6:13**). Pray to be able to stand firm, that you may stand perfect and fully assured in all the will of God. Pray for self-control, one of the fruits of the spirit. Pray that you have the endurance of the Apostle John.

21. Pray that you **may not be deceived** but **have discernment for the truth**. Pray that all the followers of Christ will be able to differentiate between truth and error. 22. Pray for a **double anointing of the Holy Spirit**. God has promised that in the last days, His Holy Spirit will be poured out afresh on all flesh and all nations will be reached. **Joel 2:28-29**, “And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.”

23. Pray for **Godly Wisdom** to know how to navigate the coming chaos. **James 3:17**, “But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.”

24. **A Prayer for Leadership:** Dear God, we are grateful to live in a country where we can openly pray for our leaders. One of Paul’s very first instructions to his protégé Timothy was to pray, “for kings and all those in authority that we may live peaceful lives in all godliness and holiness” (**1 Timothy 2:2 KJV**). Lord, virtually every aspect of our daily lives is affected in some way by the officials elected to govern our cities, states, and nations. Please give them strong, wise, and spiritually mature judgements. Reveal your heart and enable them to hear your voice clearly and distinctly, then govern in the way that brings glory to your name. **Acts 10:34 KJV**, “*Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons.*”

25. **A Prayer for Global Warming:** Dear God, the climate crisis is one of the most pressing issues of our time. We have a collective responsibility to care for God’s creation, and prayer can make a profound difference. **2 Chronicles 7:14 KJV**, “*If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.*”

**26. A Prayer for Wars and Rumors of Wars:** Dear God, wars often arising from economic, territorial, religious, or political reasons can leave countries worn and torn requiring decades for infrastructure and rebuilding. We pray for the cessation of the Israel/Palestine conflict, Russia/ Ukraine conflict, Ethiopia, Myanmar, Afghanistan, Samalia, Haiti and all civil war conflicts and the drug wars of Columbia and Mexico and all illegal drug trafficking. **Romans 14:19 KJV** says, *“Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another”*. **Matthew 5:9** says, *“Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.”* **1Timothy 2:2 KJV** says, *“for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.”* Amen!

And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
